BEACON LIGHT ON—DAVID BURG



DAVID BURG

In 1969, David Burg, an aspiring, young Houston man came to work for the Flight School at the Lake-side Airport. David cleaned aircraft and swept T-hangar floors while going to school

Over the years, David, always the self-made entrepreneur, tried various business ventures. But in 1989,

he started Cytex a plastics extrusion Company: a point of purchase company, including the manufacturing, merchandizing and distribution of plastic related products. With one machine and help from a partner, David was selling extruded plastics bagging and shipping his products to such named companies as K-Mart, Wal-mart Auto Zone and Sears.

When David's business began to boom nationally, he came to West Houston with a dream, "Woody, find me a small jet aircraft that you would feel the best for my business mission." With that mission and after a diligent search, a low time Citation 501SP was located and this plane became David and Cytex's first entry into sales

nationwide. Later David purchased a Cessna 182 in which he learned to fly.

His company grew and employees hit 80 plus with over \$17 million in annual sales.

After ten years of operating history with the 501SP, Cytex needed a bigger, faster longer range plane so a Citation 560 Ultra was acquired.

A 2006 Cessna 206 with G1000 equipment replaced the Cessna 182.

Today both David and his son, Patrick, are pilots flying out of West Houston Airport, their home base.

David is also in the process of building a hangar hideout on his lots at IWS.

IWS's Beacon Light is on David Burg in June 2010.
