The Jeffrey J. Weiss Tragedy—Revisited

If you are a regular of the YouTube channel and enjoy watching and learning from plane crash episodes, you have no doubt watched the two recent episodes (FligDebrief and Pilot Debrief with Hoover) of the accident sequence involving our beloved patron, pilot and plane owner, Jeffrey J. Weiss who perished in a Beechcraft 58 Baron crash near Kerrville Texas.

On the morning of April 22, 2019, at approximately 7:30 AM, Weiss, along with five of his close, well healed, friends, took off from the West Houston Airport enroute to the Kerrville airport and in a matter of a little more than an hour, they would all be dead when their aircraft ran out of fuel. The NTSB assigned Michael J. Folkerts to investigate the crash. Folkerts decided early on that the plane ran out of fuel, but he erroneously concluded the reason for the fuel starvation. During Folkerts investigation he relied almost entirely on a non-compos-certificated (not a substitute for OEM instrumentation) engine analyzer which had previously been determined to be inaccurate and installed erroneously. The JPI gauge and transducers installed on the engines, recorded incorrectly the fuel consumption, remaining fuel, and other parameters, all of which should not have been relied on for credible accurate aircraft performance, which Folkerts admitted to doing.

Folkerts, without any corroborating evidence, concluded that during the initial top off by airport personnel, the outboard tanks of the Baron, were not completely filled. He stated that this resulted in Weiss having less fuel than he thought. He also blamed Beaver Aircraft Service for not checking the fuel tank sending units for accuracy, which is rarely performed by any maintenance facilities. Folkerts concocted a scenario in which Jeffrey never preflighted the aircraft to determine if his tanks were topped off before the first of six flights Jeffery made with full fuel and thirty gallons of additional fuel added later. That added up to 224 total gallons that Jeffery had for the six flights he made. Despite the fact that Jeffery wrote down exactly how much fuel he had from the very beginning of the first flight, and then added an additional thirty gallons, Folkerts speculated that there were fifteen gallons or thereabouts less fuel than what was documented and as testified by witnesses. The airport along with Chief Pilot Hank Henry, and myself, over the opposition of Folkerts, determined that Jeffrey flew seven hours with six takeoffs and five landings before the crash, resulting in a Hobbs meter reading of seven hours of "flight" time. The Hobbs does NOT record when the Baron was operating on the ground. This number, based on exact evidence from the plane and records plus fuel for taxi out, takeoff and taxi in, proved beyond a doubt that 224 gallons of fuel was delivered into the tanks of the Beech 58 Baron that crashed.

This amount of fuel proved enough for the flight albeit without reserves, and in fact Jeffrey flew PAST the Kerrville airport while making an approach, which under the circumstances was not warranted and was the determining factor that lead to Jeffery running out of fuel and crashing killing all on board.

The NTSB report, prepared by Folkerts concluded erroneously and deliberately with malice, that the fuel tanks of the Beech Baron were not topped off prior to the six flights, that Jeffrey did not check them and that his own written flight log stated erroneously the amount of fuel in the tanks. Nothing could be more irrelevant than a non-compos mentis who will not look at all the facts and be inquisitive as to evidence. Thus with the NTSB report in hand, the AOPA Air Safety Institute, FligDebrief, Pilot Debrief's and the American Bonanza Society's presentations on YouTube and during training sessions, regurgitated disinformation that Folkerts reported as a fabrication of the events surrounding the Jeffrey Weiss Tragedy. "Garbage In Garbage out!"

This is the very reason that all information gathered from investigations be fully scrutinized for accuracy before disseminating to others



The airport has not had any incursions for several years.

It is recommended that you use short field landing procedures and after touch down slow quickly as is safe, in order to be able to stop within the distance you can see down the runway with your landing lights. As pilot in command, you are the one making the decisions.


