My Wishlist for the 119th 2027 Congressional Session, Pilots Bill of Rights 3.0:

- No privatization of ATC.
- No ADSB use for taxing aircraft, like HCAD does!
- No more certificate suspension for minor, nonrepetitive FAR violation.
Monetary fines only for non-gross negligence issues.
- Appointment of new non airline pilot examiners to reduce months long backlog.
- Applications for FAA approval process including FAR 135, FAR 141, FAR 145 certificates reduced to six months maximum time after receipt of application.
- Mandate FAA to allow third parties to pay for fuel for charitable flights particularly young eagles.
- Mandatory instrument approach procedure to all US airports receiving federal grants, allowing airports to be used in all weather conditions.
- FAA/FCC required to issue additional unicom frequencies for non-towered airports- long overdue
- Prohibit random ramp checks at all airports. Allow only with “probable cause”.
- Class “G” open to the public airports with fuel sales and paved runway to be allowed protection from “no notice” drone operations, same as class “B”, “C” and “D” airports.
- Privately owned open to the public airports not receiving federal funds will receive rebate of all federal fuel taxes collected on fuel sales at that airport for their airport improvements and routine maintenance.
- NOTAM update: Establish a NOTAM website where pilots, plane owners, airports and other interested parties can register and have NOTAMs sent to them as requested. The registration would limit the number of NOTAMs based on criteria selected by the applicant.
